# The Walden School Creative Musicians Retreat INFORMATION FOR PERFORMERS

A week-long festival in New Hampshire, The Walden School Creative Musicians Retreat (CMR) is offered for composers, improvisers, performers, electronic musicians, choral musicians, and music teachers who want to spend a week immersed in music. In 2020, the festival will be held June 13-21.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I need to audition?

An audition is not required. Please submit 2-3 recent recordings with your application. What performance level is expected?

We place students in ensembles and select repertoire based on the level of the participants. While a range of repertoire may be explored, the focus tends to be on contemporary music. *Can I attend with my chamber group?* 

Yes. Reduced tuition is available for chamber groups. Inquire for details.

Can I attend the Retreat if my instrument isn't represented among the faculty/artists-in-residence?

Absolutely. Even if we cannot offer private lessons in a particular instrument, you can participate as a chamber musician.

Can I write a piece and have it performed?

Yes. We welcome composer-performers who want to write and perform at the retreat.
